The Pact for Education is an initiative that adapts result oriented management tools to the State's education system. Some of the adopted management concepts are:

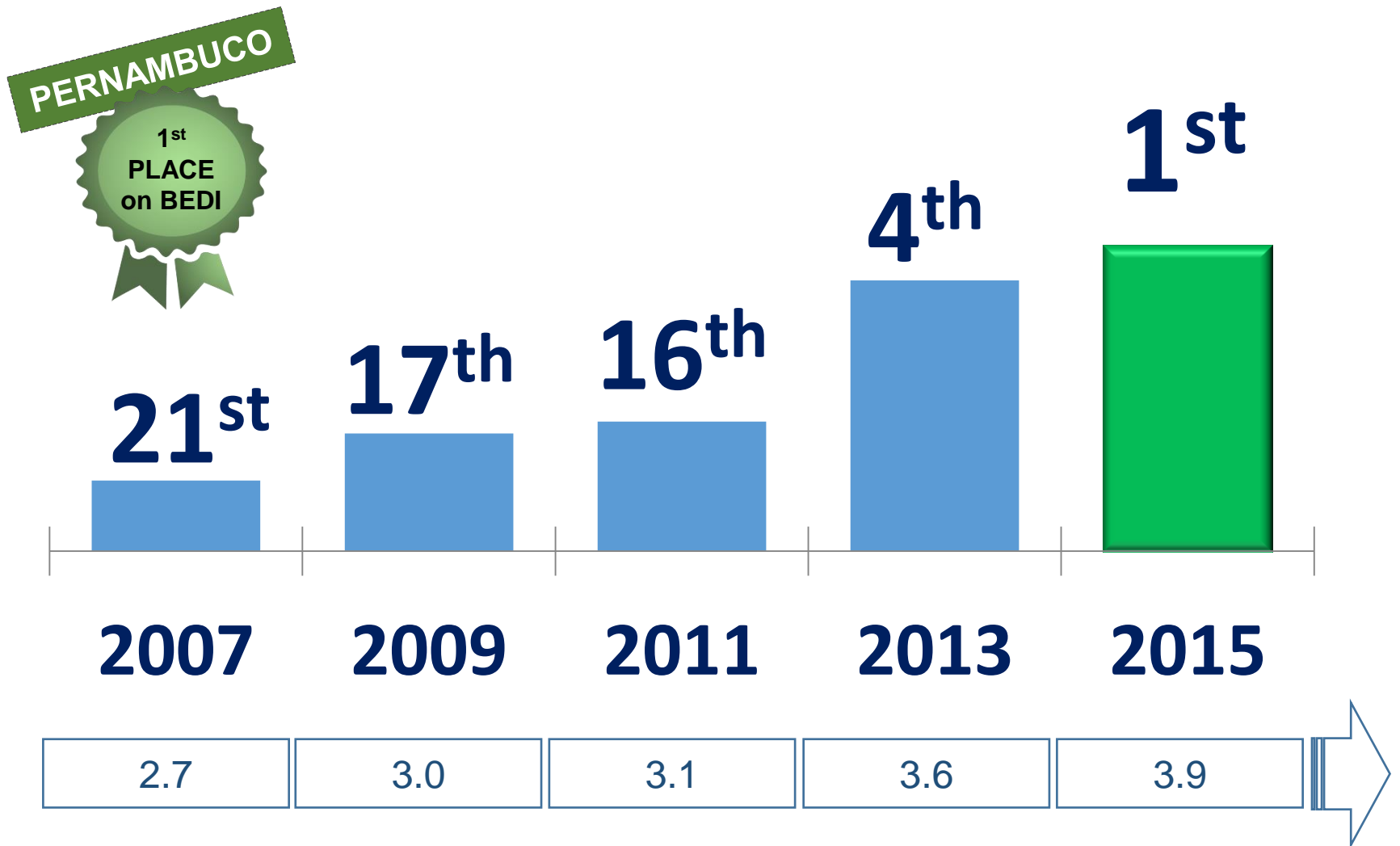

BASIC EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT INDEX

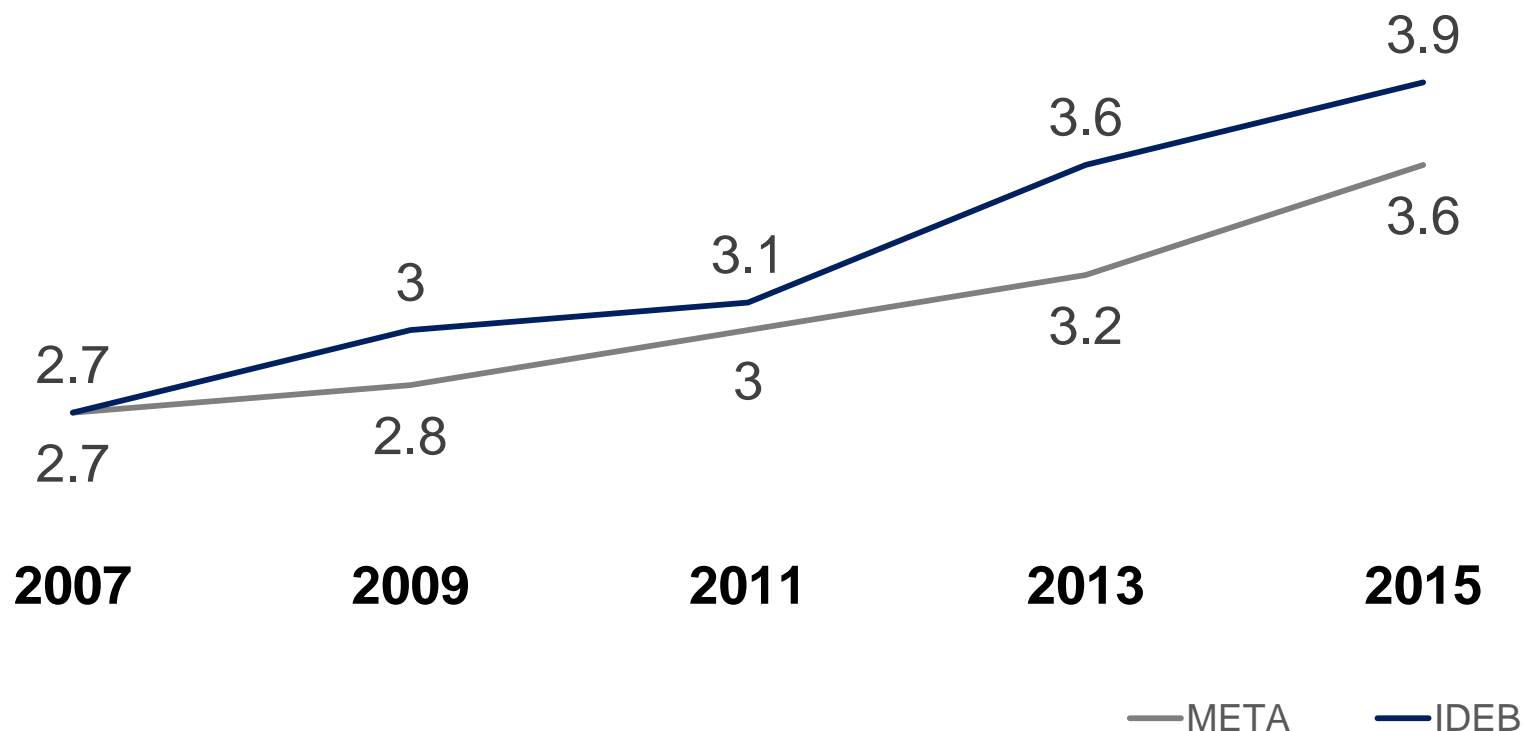

Secondary Schools – State System



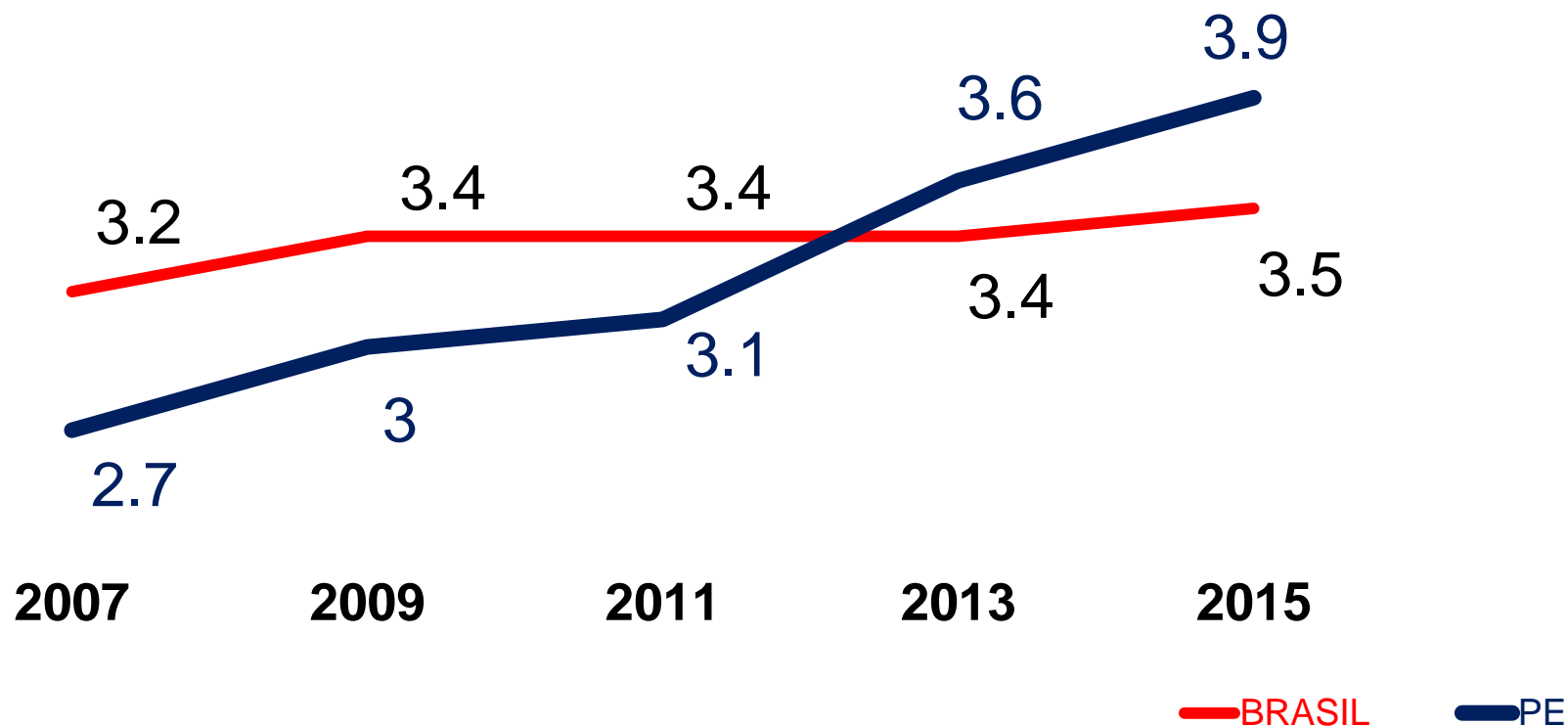

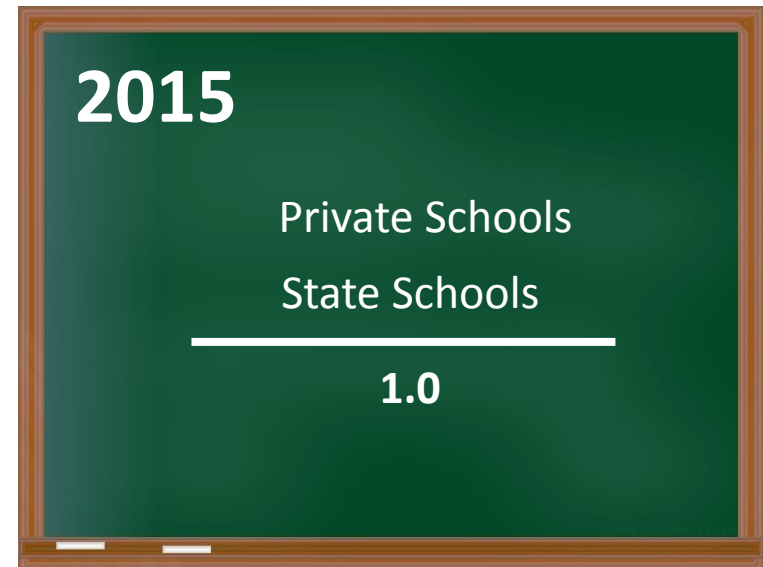

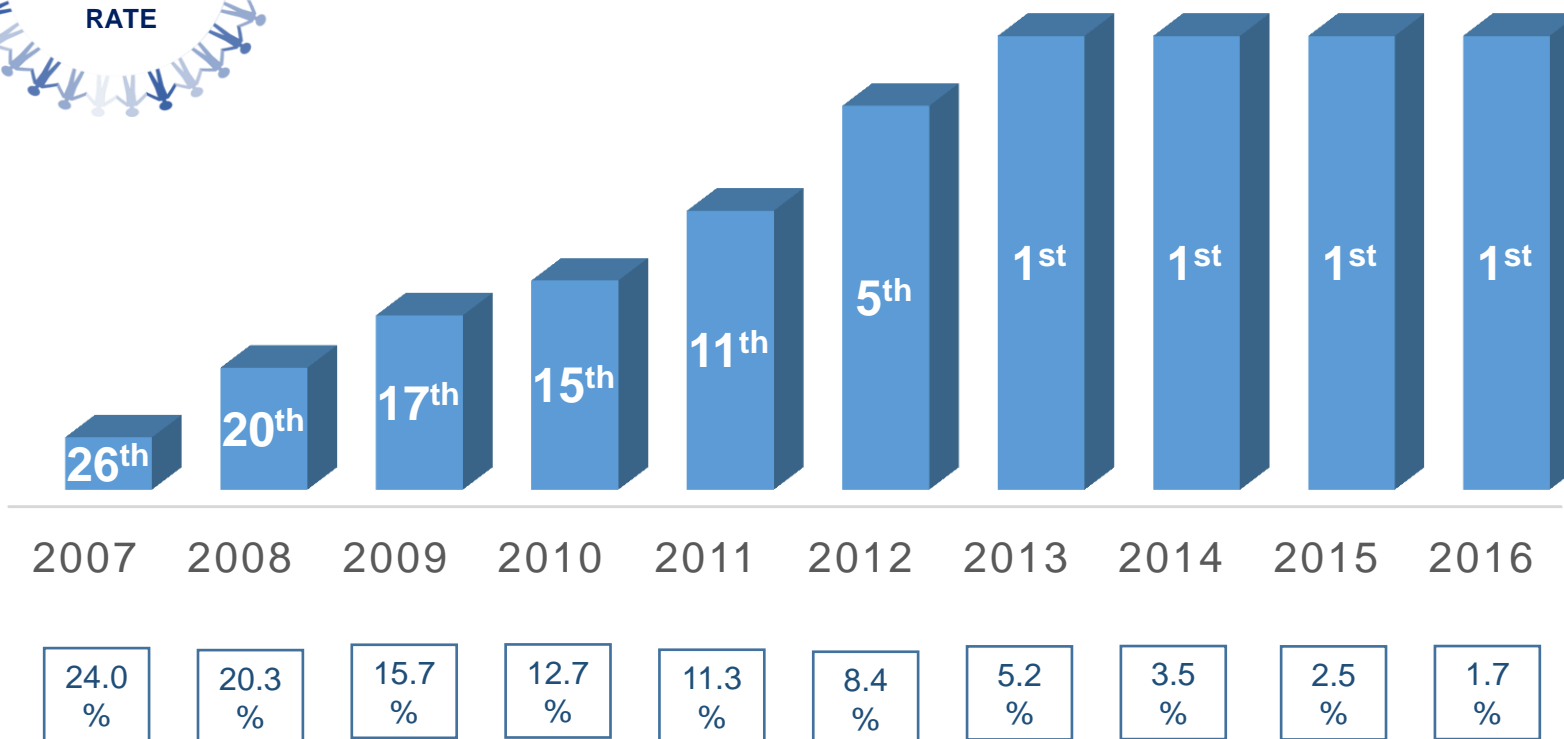
DROPOUT RATE REDUCTION

Highest reduction in Brazil between 2007 - 2016: - 94,4%

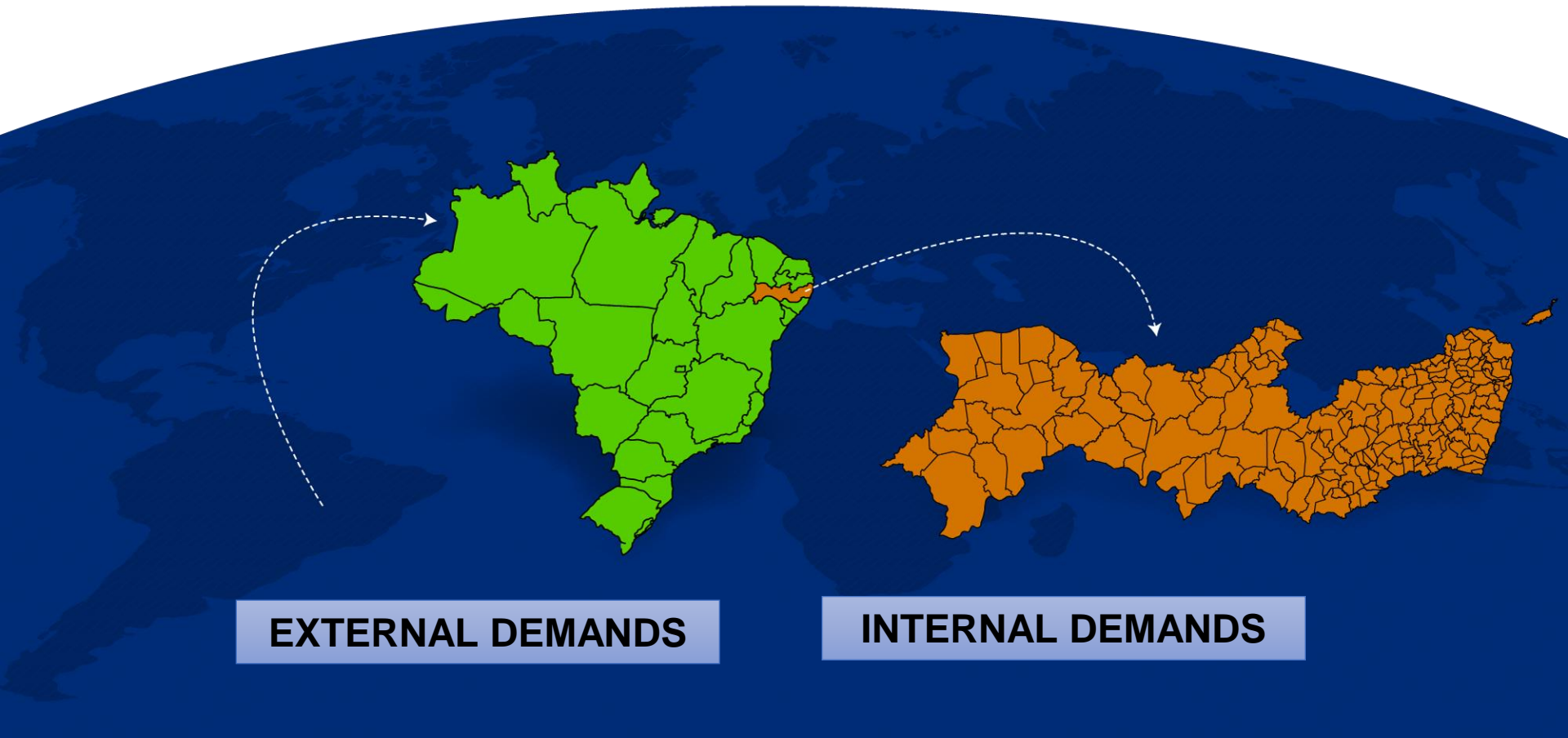

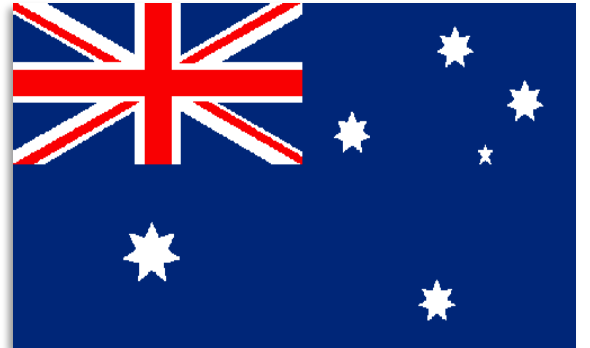

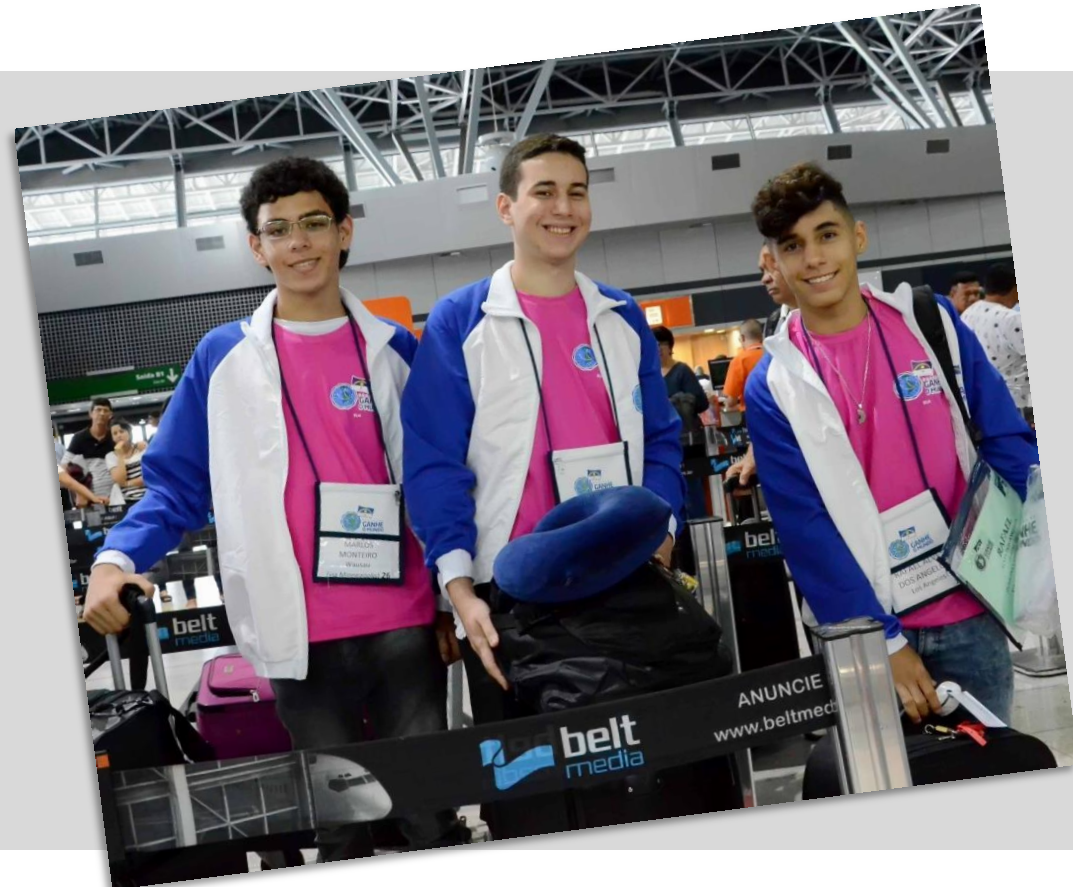
- 🌐 **Enrollment:** regularly enrolled in the first year of high school in a state public school
